



The “Visits” section in the M+ Care app is where you can view your upcoming schedule, view open visits, and apply to open visits


## 1 Navigation

- From the side menu > select “Visits”




## 2 View Schedule

- The “My Visits” tab will show your upcoming schedule by day
- Select the booking to view visit details



- Jump to a specific day by selecting the arrow below the calendar, to expand the calendar




- Dates with a blue dot indicate you have a scheduled visit on that day


The “Visits” section in the M+ Care app is where you can view your upcoming schedule, view open visits, and apply to open visits

## 3 View Open Visits



- The “Open Visits” tab will show you all open visits available for you to apply to, sorted by date
- Dates with an orange dot indicate there is an open visit available on that day
- Clients with a star beside their name are recommended for you
- Select “More” to filter open visits list (ie view only one-time visits, visits within a certain distance, or visits with clients you have worked with)
- Select an open visit to view details

## 4 View Open Visit Details



- Visit start and end date, and occurrence
- Visit day and time
- Client information
- Care location intersection and distance from your home
- Description of visit

## 5 Apply to Open Visits

- If you are available and interested in working a visit, select “Apply”

- Confirm the visits you would like to apply to by selecting (green checkmark) or unselecting the dates you do not wish to apply to
- Select “Confirm”

- You will receive a prompt confirming your application

- View all visits you have applied and declined under the “Applied” and “Declined” tabs from the Open Visits main page
